Take a picnic rug or find a well placed bench seat along the way and enjoy! A great family friendly walk located within 100 metres of our property is The Stone Quarry Walk. The walk runs along the western bank of the Wingecarribee River and is easily accessible from the centre of the village with a large black sign at the entrance – you can't miss it! It's all about strolling along the river bank enjoying the view and taking in the fresh country air with so many fab picnic spots along the way.

This walk is also known to have guest appearances by the elusive platypus appearing at dawn and dusk. Take a seat, sit quietly and see if you can spot one. A staff favourite for afternoon sundowners and picnics. Ask Nettie on reception if you would like a rug and picnic basket. Enjoy!



As the Autumn trees explode into hues of gold, red, and orange, our sleeping bulbs beneath the earth are ready to shoot, with tulips, daffodils, irises, bellflowers and pink spider lilies, you are in for a treat as you stroll around the garden. See if you can spot our Oakleaf Hydrangeas with their rusted gold flowers as you look onto the peaceful Wingecarribee River while reading a book or taking a walk. We hope you enjoy our 2 acres of manicured gardens.

If you are feeling inspired by our river front location, you might like to do the Berrima river walk. Pop into reception and ask for a self guided audio bookmark. The river walk follows the German merchant seamen camp sites built during World War 1. The river walk takes about an hour (1.8 kms) and is absolutely fascinating. Flat walking shoes are recommended as the path can be slippery in wet conditions.

"Berrima is a perfectly preserved Georgian village, one of only three still standing in Australia today and filled with captivating stories", says founder Lynn Watson.

Berrima Walking Tours offers small group public tours every Friday, Saturday and Sunday at 10.00am and bespoke private tours for groups of six or more upon request. Her Excellency the Honourable Margaret Beazley AC KC, Governor of New South Wales, unveiled the bronze statue of local pioneering woman, Charlotte Atkinson in the Berrima MarketPlace Park on the 9th of December 2023.

According to an article in the Sydney Morning Herald, Charlotte Atkinson (1796–1867) was "one of the most accomplished women of her era." She was a fiercely independent, well-educated woman – a teacher with progressive views on girls' education, a pioneer in the fight for women's legal rights, a botanist, poet, accomplished artist, and the first Australian children's author.

Only about 4 percent of statues in Australia are of women and The Charlotte Project is part of a movement to redress this imbalance.

When you next visit Berrima, take the time to see the beautiful statue of Charlotte Atkinson sitting on a sandstone block, close to the children's park, just a short stroll from the motel. We have a well read copy of "Searching for Charlotte" you are welcome to read during your stay.

Apolate on sale of the Gard

Berrima Gaol, a former correctional facility in the Southern Highlands of NSW, is to be redeveloped into a hotel and entertainment precinct following a \$7 million sale to Blue Sox Group.

As part of a "rigorous" Expressions of Interest process, Blue Sox's winning proposal carefully considered the heritage-listed buildings on site and their historical significance to the local community.

"The proposal incorporates a boutique hotel whilst retaining the beautiful grounds of the estate, and will include café, restaurant, bar, community and event areas, and spaces which will cater for small business opportunities such as antiques and book shops, personal services, art galleries, library and museum," said Minister for Planning and Minister for Homes, Anthony Roberts.
