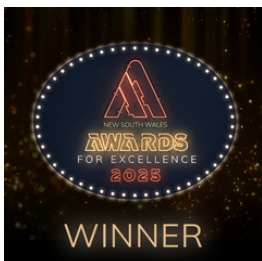

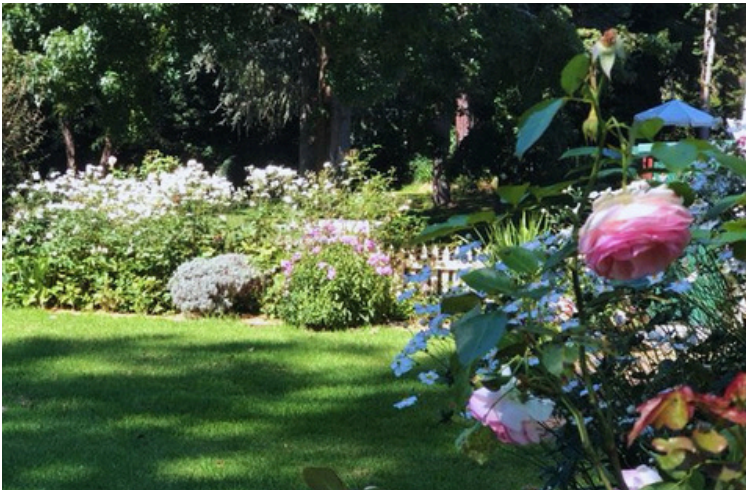

Ambulant Room

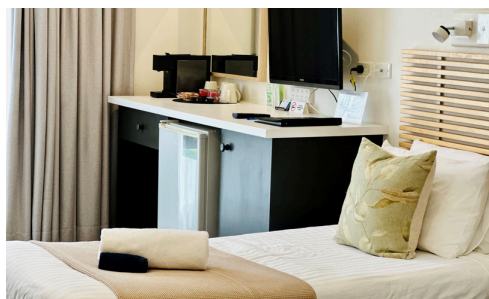
